PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

The next GEORGIA Pecan Report is scheduled to be released in late September or early October, 2016. The next LOUISIANA Pecan Report is scheduled to be released in mid-October, 2016. The next OKLAHOMA Pecan Report is scheduled to be released in late October or early November, 2016. The next TEXAS Pecan Report is scheduled to be released in late October or early November, 2016.

WESTERN REGION - ARIZONA, NEW MEXICO AND WEST TEXAS (via: Phoenix, Arizona)

Deliveries by growers to delivery points of Improved varieties were light. Demand was good for good quality pecans. Harvested quality has been generally good. The season is finishing up, and overall is approximately 90-95% complete, and is expected to be generally done by the end of January.

The weather forecast for the next week calls for low temperatures in the low 20s to mid-40s, with highs in the low 40s to mid-70s. There is a 0-20% chance of precipitation on Tuesday, January 26 and on Monday, February 1. No precipitation projected for the other days this week.

Buying interest displayed by end users was fairly good for in-shell, gift pack use, and fairly good for commercial sheller use as shellers continue to utilize inventories on hand or make purchases from other production areas or wait for additional availability of nuts. Trading was moderate for in-shell and gift pack uses. Deliveries and purchases of Improved varieties mostly Western Schley were moderate.

Prices paid to growers (noon Tuesday, January 19 through noon Tuesday, January 26, 2016) at buyers delivery point or f.o.b. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality pecans in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.
