### PRICES PAID TO GROWERS THE NEXT GEORGIA, LOUISIANA AND TEXAS PECAN REPORTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE ISSUED IN LATE SEPTEMBER 2014.

OKLAHOMA (via: Phoenix, Arizona)

Deliveries by growers to buying points were very light. Demand has been slow. Harvesting is expected to decrease seasonally as most areas of the state are finished for the season.

The weather forecast for the balance of the week calls for temperature highs in the mid 30s to mid 40s, and temperature lows in the low 20s to low 30s.

Buying interest displayed by end users was moderate for retail inshell gift pack use, and very slow for commercial sheller use as shellers utilize inventories on hand or make purchases from other production areas. Many growers have opted to put their remaining pecans in cold storage and plan to sell them at a later date. Trading was moderate for in-shell and gift pack uses.

Prices paid to growers at buyers delivery points or F.O.B. the orchard (from noon Tuesday, January 21, 2014 to noon Thursday, January 30, 2014) cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.

#### WESTERN REGION - ARIZONA, NEW MEXICO AND WEST TEXAS (via Phoenix, Arizona)

Deliveries by growers to delivery points of Improved varieties were very light. Demand was light. Harvesting is generally finished for the season, and is expected to decrease seasonally. Some growers have put their remaining pecans in cold storage and plan to sell at a later date.

The weather forecast for the balance of the week calls for low temperatures in the low 30s to low 40s, with highs in the low 60s to low 70s.

Buying interest and trading displayed by end users was moderate for in-shell gift pack use, and very slow for commercial sheller use as shellers continue to utilize inventories on hand or make purchases from other production areas. Deliveries and purchases of Improved varieties mostly Western Schley, were very light.

Prices paid to growers (from noon Tuesday, January 21, 2014 to noon Thursday, January 30, 2014) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality pecans in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.
