PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

The weather forecast shows temperatures throughout the state in a cooling trend with wind and rain coming in from the West. Some areas may expect high winds and tornado warnings today and early tomorrow. Evening lows expected to be in the mid 40s to mid 60s with daytime highs in the low 70s to low 80s.

More pecans have hit the market, but indications of a wait and see approach has buyers scrambling to either adjust their bids higher or growers may hold their pecans for sale later this afternoon or for the weekend. Prices appear to be heading higher. Rain is expected in all Pecan growing regions, so speculation is that a higher priced market is coming, especially with the Western areas getting plenty of water in the orchards.

Offerings of Stuart Blends, Schley Blends and Desirable Blends with 48-52% meat yield sold in a range of about \$3.80-3.91 per point. Moneymaker Blends with 44-46% meat yield sold in a wide range of \$2.83-3.43 per point.

The retail gift pack business is fairly active, the export trade is expected to increase this month while domestic trading for today is moderate.

Rain has created issues with getting started for most growers and harvest is expected to begin today. Mild temperatures for today through Wednesday and a cooling trend on Thursday with evening temperatures in the 40s and more rain is expected. It may be a short crop this year. Very light offerings coming in at the door and growers are just now collecting and gathering the pecans for grading and testing for sales at a later time.
