PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Phoenix, Arizona)

The weather forecast through Thursday, November 19 in South Georgia projects low temperatures in the low 50s to low 70s, highs in the low 70s to low 80s, and a chance of precipitation every day between now and Thursday, November 19, with as high as a 90 percent chance of precipitation in some areas on Thursday, November 19.

The weather forecast through Thursday, November 19 in Central and North Georgia projects low temperatures in the mid-40s to low 60s, highs in the mid-60s to mid-70s, and a 80% chance of precipitation on Wednesday, November 18 and a 20% chance of precipitation on Thursday, November 19.

Buying interest is active for export quality pecans and for good quality pecans. For the wholesale and gift pack trade demand is strong as the holiday season approaches. An increase in sales were reported this week.

Blends in both small and large lots of generally good quality with meat yields of 40-44% sold for about \$3.78-4.02 per point. Schley Blends of gift pack quality with at least 50% meat yields sold for about \$4.00-4.15 per point. Stuart Blends with meat yields of 40-42% sold for about \$3.70-3.90 per point. (To get price per pound use this formula: dollars per point times meat yield = cents per pound; to get per point figure: dollars per pound divided by meat yield = dollars per point).

Prices paid to growers (Thursday, November 12 through Tuesday, November 17, 2015) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality pecans in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.

Desirables (deliveries light) export quality 50-51% meat yield 260-265; 47-48% meat yield 240-250, yard tree lots 120-135 few high as 150-170

Elliott (deliveries very light) 49-52% meat yield (nut count 65-75) 190-210, yard tree lots 140-150 few high as 175

Moneymakers (deliveries light) 42% meat yield (nut count 70-72) 151, yard tree lots 100
