PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Phoenix, Arizona)

The pecan season continues to get underway across Georgia. Most buyers are anticipating being underway by the end of next week. Pawnee, Seedlings, Stuart, Moneymakers, Elliott and Schley are showing up on the market and some Desirables and possibly Cape Fear will be ready to market this week.

This past week, temperatures ranged from lows in the upper 30s to low 60s, and highs in the mid-60s to upper 80s. There was slight levels of precipitation on Tuesday, October 13, otherwise, the past week saw little in the way of precipitation. The upcoming week has projected lows in the mid-40s to low 60s, highs in the mid-60s to mid-80s, and a 10-20 percent chance of precipitation most days.

Prices paid to growers (October 13 through October 20, 2015) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality. Very light sales were reported. Prices include trailer load lots and lots under 20,000 pounds.
