PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park, Georgia) Atlanta

The pecan season is running late this year. The rain and cool weather did not open up the pecans on the trees as the growers had hoped for this week. Desirables and Stuarts were expected to start hitting the market, but were not ready at the time of this report. Schleys along with some Money Makers should be coming in the next week or soon after. A few Caddo and Oconee have come in but were too few in number to establish a market. A few lots of Pawnee sold this week and door sales of various varieties are starting to come in. Temperature lows for the week range from the low 40s to mid 40s with highs of the mid 70s to low 80s and mostly sunny to partly cloudy days throughout the state.

Very light deliveries at the door for yard tree lots and large lots including trailer loads from Tuesday, October 14, 2014 thru late afternoon Tuesday, October 21, 2014. Large lots of Pawnee export quality pecans with nut counts of 51-55 and meat yields of 57-58 per cent sold in a range of about \$3.00-3.15. Other lots of Pawnee sold in a range of about \$2.10-2.37.

Prices paid to growers (late afternoon Tuesday, October 14, 2014 thru late afternoon Tuesday, October 21, 2014) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.
