PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

The weather for the next week shows a cooling trend throughout the state with evening lows from the mid to low 60s cooling down to the low 40s and low 50s. Daytime highs are expected to be from the low 60s to low 70s with rain today and Friday.

Light shipments reported from large lots but smaller lots are coming onto the market now. Some have been contracted out. The retail gift pack business is active and will be slowing down as many have already made purchases or have contracts for future business. The export trade is starting to show interest but is still slow in conducting business while the domestic trade is fairly active this week.

Small lots of Stuart Blends with (55-65 nut count) and 46-48% meat yields sold in a range of about \$3.20-4.02, mostly \$3.60-3.80 per point. Other lots of Blends with (68-75 nut count) and 46-50% meat yields sold for about \$3.40-3.50 per point.

Prices paid to growers (late afternoon October 23, 2018 thru late afternoon October 25, 2018) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.

LOUISIANNA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

The season is getting a slow start. Very light offerings at the door and insufficient offerings to establish a market for commercial volume. Currently no F.O.B. issued until volume and sales increase. Expected F.O.B. to be issued around October 30 if volume increases. At this time buyers are still working on determining prices and growers are gathering the pecans for market.

The Oklahoma, Texas and New Mexico pecan reports are expected to be released around the first week of November.
