PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Phoenix, Arizona)

The weather forecast for the next week in South Georgia calls for low temperatures in the mid-50s to upper 60s, and highs in the mid-70s to low 80s. There is a 10-60 percent chance of precipitation for the following week, with Tuesday, November 3, having the greatest chance at 60 percent.

The weather forecast for the next week in Central and North Georgia calls for low temperatures in the mid-40s to low 60s, and highs in the low 60s to upper 70s. There is a chance of precipitation every day the following week except for Friday, October 30. Sunday, November 1 and Monday, November 2 have the greatest chance of precipitation, at 90-100 percent.

Buying interest displayed by end users was good for in-shell gift pack use, export quality pecans, and good quality smaller sized pecans, while moderate for others.

Blends were sold for about \$4.00-4.08 per point for generally good quality pecans with 52% meat yield, and for about \$3.75-4.00 per point with 44-46% meat yields. (To get price per pound use this formula: dollars per point times meat yield = cents per pound; to get per point figure: dollars per pound divided by meat yield = dollars per point).

Prices paid to growers (October 27 through October 29, 2015) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct

sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality. Very light sales were reported. Prices include trailer load lots and lots under 20,000 pounds.

Elliott (deliveries very light) 50-52% meat yield (under 70 count) 200-220 49-50% meat yield (nut count 75-80) 190-200, 43-45% meat yield (nut count 80-85) 150-175 mostly 160-170

LOUISIANA (via Phoenix, Arizona)

(LA report will be issued once weekly-usually on Thursdays)

Some growers have begun harvest, while most others expect to start harvest during the next two weeks, weather permitting. Rain has been reported in most areas of the state during the past week, with some areas receiving over three inches of rain between Friday, October 23 and Sunday, October 25. Very light volume has been collected by growers and sellers at this time. Many of the prospective sellers are waiting to see what prices will be offered before delivering them for sale. The next reporting of Louisiana pecans will be released as volume increases around November 5, 2015.
