## PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

The weather forecast for this week shows a cooling trend throughout the state with evening lows in the low 50s to mid 60s and daytime highs are expected to be from the high 70s to low 80s Rain is expected on Thursday in the north part of the state.

Offerings of Stuart Blends (55-61 nut count) 44-48% meat yield sold in a range of about \$3.40-3.82 per point, (55-60 nut count) 41-43% meat yield \$3.10-3.20 per point. Moneymaker and Stuart Blends 43-46% meat yield sold in a wide range of \$2.56-3.15 per point and Desirable Blends (52-55 nut count) 46-47% meat yield \$3.76-3.77 per point.

The retail gift pack business is fairly active and the export trade is coming into view. Domestic trading is picking up this week as volume starts to increase as prices lowered.

Rain has created issues with getting started for most growers and harvest is expected to begin today. Mild temperatures for today through Wednesday and a cooling trend on Thursday with evening temperatures in the 40s and more rain is expected. It may be a short crop this year. Very light offerings coming in at the door and growers are just now collecting and gathering the pecans for grading and testing for sales at a later time.
