PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park, Georgia) Atlanta

The pecan season is about three weeks later than in normal years. The south Georgia area orchards are just now getting ready to be harvested and the pecans ready for market. Rain curtailed harvest and preparation of orchard floors in many areas during the first week in October. For well maintained, irrigated orchards volume is expected to be considered a good year and above average. For dry land orchards, the volume is expected to be short of a normal year. Temperatures for this week range from lows of mid 60s to highs of mid 80s and from sunny to partly cloudy throughout the state. Some areas could have sporadic showers and thunderstorms later this week.

No sales and deliveries at the door have been reported as buyers are preparing to open their doors for business on Monday, October 13 and as late as October 20. Deliveries of large lots are expected to start next week with Pawnee and possibly some Stuarts with the majority of deliveries expected to start the week after, around October 21-24.

Prices paid to growers (Wednesday, October 1, 2014 thru late afternoon Thursday, October 9, 2014) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality. Very light sales of Pawnee were reported. Prices include trailer load lots and lots under 20,000 pounds.
