Hurricane season is upon us once again and with it came Hurricane Irma. Many areas have been affected; from Florida through the Carolinas and Alabama. Georgia had significant damage with growers reporting losses ranging from 20 percent up to 35 percent with most reporting 30 percent loss of the crop. Many trees were down and toppled over including young trees with plenty of nuts on them. The Pawnee took a big hit as well as some young Stuarts. Desirables and Schleys are starting to open up now.

Most growers are busy cleaning up their orchards from debris and broken limbs, hoping to be able to get to the pecans sitting on the ground blown off from all the winds and rainstorms. A few Pawnee have been harvested and should hit the market soon. Next week is expected to be busy as shellers and accumulators should have their doors open around October 2.

Currently, no established prices have been set yet.
