HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen food stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31, 2002, were greater than year earlier levels for beef, pork, orange juice and potatoes.

Butter stocks were 81 percent above December 2001 and 48 percent above a year ago.

Total red meat supplies in freezers were 3 percent above December 2001 and 7 percent above January 2001. Frozen pork stocks were 8 percent above last month and 7 percent above last year. Stocks of pork bellies were 14 percent above last month and 1 percent above January 2001 stocks.

Total frozen poultry supplies on January 31, 2002, were up 8 percent from last month but were 1 percent below last year's level. Total stocks of chicken were slightly below last month and 5 percent below last year. Total pounds of turkey in freezers increased 33 percent from last month and 10 percent from last year.

Public cooler occupancy on January 31, 2002, was at 36 percent of capacity, up 1 point from last year. Public freezer occupancy, at 47 percent, was down 8 percentage points from last year.
