Update Alert

Apples in public warehouse stocks was omitted from page 4. The total stocks of apples in public warehouses should have been 7,946.

Highlights

Frozen Food stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31, 2004 were below last year's levels for poultry, red meat, and orange juice concentrate.

Butter stocks were up 45 percent from last month, but 29 percent below last year.

Total red meat supplies in freezers were 9 percent above last month, but 5 percent below January 31, 2003. Frozen pork stocks were 9 percent above last month's levels but only slightly below last year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 29 percent from last month and up 78 percent from last year.

Total frozen poultry supplies on January 31, 2004 were down 2 percent from last month, and down 20 percent from last year. Total stocks of chicken were down 13 percent from last month, and down 26 percent from a year ago. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 16 percent from last month, but down 9 percent from January 31, 2003.
