HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen food stocks in refrigerated warehouses on August 31, 2001, were greater than year earlier levels for orange juice, turkeys and potatoes. Cooler stocks of apples were also higher than a year earlier.

Butter stocks were 23 percent below July 2001 but were 11 percent above a year ago.

Total red meat supplies in freezers were 2 percent above July 2001 but were 18 percent below August 2000. Frozen pork stocks were 2 percent below last month and were 27 percent below last year. Stocks of pork bellies decreased 51 percent from last month and were 63 percent below August 2000 stocks.

Total frozen poultry supplies on August 31, 2001, were down 1 percent from last month and were 12 percent below last year's level. Total stocks of chicken were 2 percent below last month and 23 percent below last year. Total pounds of turkey in freezers increased 1 percent from last month and were 3 percent above last year.
