## Highlights

**Total natural cheese stocks** in refrigerated warehouses on July 31, 2016 were up 2 percent from the previous month and up 10 percent from July 31, 2015. Total natural cheese stocks were a record high for the month of July, since the data was first recorded in 1917.

**Butter stocks** were up 2 percent from last month and up 31 percent from a year ago.

**Total frozen poultry supplies** on July 31, 2016 were up 2 percent from the previous month and up 7 percent from a year ago. Total stocks of chicken were up 1 percent from the previous month and up 7 percent from last year. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 5 percent from last month and up 7 percent from July 31, 2015.

**Total frozen fruit stocks** were up 27 percent from last month and up 14 percent from a year ago. Total frozen fruit stocks were a record high for the month of July, since the data was first recorded in 1923.

**Total frozen vegetable stocks** were up 9 percent from last month and up 7 percent from a year ago. Total frozen vegetable stocks were a record high for the month of July, since the data was first recorded in 1962.

**Total red meat supplies** in freezers were up 3 percent from the previous month but down 2 percent from last year. Total pounds of beef in freezers were up 3 percent from the previous month and up 2 percent from last year. Frozen pork supplies were up 2 percent from the previous month but down 5 percent from last year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 20 percent from last month but up 114 percent from last year.
