## HIGHLIGHTS

**Frozen food stocks** in refrigerated warehouses on May 31, 2001, were greater than year earlier levels for orange juice and potatoes. Cooler stocks of apples were also higher than a year earlier. Butter stocks were 26 percent above April 2001 but were 2 percent below a year ago.

**Total red meat supplies** in freezers were 1 percent above April 2001 but were 19 percent below May 2000. Frozen pork stocks were 2 percent below last month and were 21 percent below last year. Stocks of pork bellies increased 5 percent from last month but were 33 percent below May 2000 stocks.

**Total frozen poultry supplies** on May 31, 2001, were up 7 percent from last month but were 14 percent below last year's level. Total stocks of chicken were 2 percent above last month but were 20 percent below last year. Total pounds of turkey in freezers increased 16 percent from last month but were 6 percent below last year.
