HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen food stocks in refrigerated warehouses on December 31, 2001, were greater than year earlier levels for orange juice, red meat and potatoes.

Butter stocks were 2 percent below November 2001 but were 118 percent above a year ago.

Total red meat supplies in freezers were 7 percent above November 2001 and 12 percent above December 2000. Frozen pork stocks were also 12 percent above last month and 6 percent above last year. Stocks of pork bellies were 22 percent above last month but were 6 percent below December 2000 stocks.

Total frozen poultry supplies on December 31, 2001, were up 3 percent from last month but were 7 percent below last year's level. Total stocks of chicken were 5 percent above last month but were 11 percent below last year. Total pounds of turkey in freezers decreased 3 percent from last month but were 4 percent above last year.
