HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen food stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30, 2001, were greater than year earlier levels for orange juice, turkeys and potatoes.

Butter stocks were 8 percent below August 2001 but were 22 percent above a year ago.

Total red meat supplies in freezers were 6 percent above August 2001 but were 11 percent below September 2000. Frozen pork stocks were 11 percent above last month but were 16 percent below last year. Stocks of pork bellies decreased 30 percent from last month and were 58 percent below September 2000 stocks.

Total frozen poultry supplies on September 30, 2001, were down 1 percent from last month and were 13 percent below last year's level. Total stocks of chicken were slightly below last month and 24 percent below last year. Total pounds of turkey in freezers decreased 1 percent from last month but were 2 percent above last year.
