## PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

ARIZONA, NEW MEXICO AND WEST TEXAS (via Phoenix, Arizona) (602) 514-7210

Deliveries by growers to delivery points of Improved varieties were fairly light. Demand was moderate for good quality pecans. The season is finishing up, and harvesting is approximately 95 percent complete, and is expected to be done by mid-February. Harvested quality has been generally good.

The weather forecast for the next week calls for low temperatures in the low 10s to low 40s with highs in the upper 30s to upper 60s. There is a 10 to 20 percent chance of precipitation across most of the region on Tuesday, January 26 and Wednesday, January 27, with as high as a 60 percent chance of precipitation in the Lordsburg, New Mexico area.

The preliminary National Agricultural Statistics Service report for the 2020 season reports that Arizona produced 30,500,000 pounds of improved variety pecans, and New Mexico produced 77,000,000 pounds of improved variety pecans, making New Mexico the second largest pecan producing state in 2020, and Arizona the fourth largest (Georgia being first, and Texas third).

Buying interest displayed by end users was moderate for in-shell, gift pack use, and moderate for commercial sheller use as shellers continue to utilize inventories on hand or make purchases from other production areas or wait for additional availability of nuts. Trading was moderate for in-shell and gift pack uses. Deliveries and purchases of Improved varieties mostly Western Schley were moderate. Many growers are deferring making marketing decisions, opting instead to concentrate on harvesting and storing nuts for later sale.

Prices paid to growers (from noon Tuesday, January 19, 2021 through noon Tuesday, January 26, 2021) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality pecans in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.
