PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

Weather throughout the state has temperatures for the week warming up today with daytime highs in the high 70s and evening lows in the 60s with a thirty to fifty percent chance of rain expected for Saturday through Monday. In the North parts of the state it will be about ten degrees cooler.

Growers are preparing their pecans to be tested and offering them for sale this week with many not making any deals or sales. They are either reoffered for sale or put into storage waiting until a price can be established and accepted by both sides. Purchases by shellers and domestic buyers are moderate to slow as well as retail gift pack purchases and it is expected to pick up before the Thanksgiving push for holiday sales. The export market is slow as compared to past years, especially the movement going to Asia.

Small lots of Blends with Desirables (nut count 58-63) meat yield 51-55% sold in a range of about \$2.44-2.70 per point. Large lots of Desirable Blends (nut count 48-50) meat yield 50-53% sold in a range of about \$2.62-2.79 per point. Lots of Stuart Blends (nut count 55-62) meat yield 47-48% sold in a range of about \$2.35-2.55 per point and Schley Blends (nut count 65-75) meat yield 52-54% sold in a range of about \$2.35-2.55 per point.
