## PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

### GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

This week has the southern areas of Georgia hit with some rain and wind while growers are trying to get pecans picked up and out of the wet conditions. The export and gift pack buyers are very quiet and domestic shellers are busy finding customers to take on the extra volume that has come in this week. Prices are lower than last week and most growers with export quality pecans are holding them in storage until the price offered comes up or they will wait until after the New Year to put them up for sale.

Weather for this week shows the Southern areas of the state with evenings and early mornings in the low 70s, cooling down to the mid-60s and by Monday, November 16 cooling down to the mid-40s and low 50s with daytime temperatures a little warmer. Rain is expected most of the week and the north areas will expect less rain and cooler temps.

Small lots of Blends with Desirables (nut count 51-65) meat yield 48-55% sold in a range of about \$2.01-2.63 mostly \$2.18-2.40 per point. Schley Blends (nut count 60-70) meat yield 50-54% sold in a range of about \$2.40-2.60 per point, Stuart Blends (nut count 50-63) meat yield 46-52% sold in a range of about \$2.40-2.60 (nut count 50-60) meat yield 43-44% sold for about \$2.00-2.20 per point. Other small lots of Blends (nut count 52-62) meat yield 49-52% sold in a range of about \$2.13-2.61 mostly \$2.20-2.50 per point.

Large lots of Desirable Blends (nut count 48-54) meat yield 49-52% sold in a range of about \$2.52-2.76 per point Schley Blends (nut count 60-70) meat yield 50-54% sold in a range of about \$2.40-2.60 per point Stuart Blends (nut count 50-60) meat yield 48-52% sold in a range of about \$2.40-2.60 per point

Weather for the week has evening lows in the high 60s cooling down to the mid-40s by the weekend and daytime highs in the low 80s and cooling down to the low 70s by early next week. There is a 7-15 percent chance of rain during the week. Some growers have lost trees because of the hurricanes and storms that came through recently and many are reporting no crop for this year because of weather and growing conditions.
