PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

The weather throughout the state for today through next Tuesday shows rather mild temperatures with evening lows in the mid-60s and daytime highs in the high 70s to low 80s with the Northern areas of the state cooler by about ten degrees. Rain can be expected almost every day.

Deliveries tapered off this week and growers are picking up their pecans and preparing them for market while watching the prices stabilize. Prices are about steady or slightly lower and remain rather strong this week. Some growers anticipate a short crop and are waiting for the cooler temps to drop the leaves and then will go in and shake one time instead of doing two or three passes in the orchards. This will save time and money. Desirables have hit the markets and Schley and Stuarts are ready to show up soon. Export business is in the mix now while some domestic buyers are taking a slow approach for purchases waiting for prices to drop. The retail and holiday gift candy buyers are active.

Prices paid to growers (late afternoon October 22, 2019 through late afternoon October 24, 2019) at buyers delivery point or F.O.B. the orchard including direct sales to end users, cents per pound in-shell of generally good quality in lots of 20,000 pounds or less unless otherwise stated.
