PRICES PAID TO GROWERS

GEORGIA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta, GA)

Weather for this week shows nice temps starting in the high 60s and cooling to the mid-50s for Friday and Saturday. Warming back up into the low 70s for next Tuesday. Possible freezing for the evenings and early mornings of Saturday and Sunday with mostly sunny days. In the North areas of the state it will be cooler with rain expected on Wednesday and storms on Thursday with rain again on Tuesday of next week. There are freeze warnings for Saturday and Sunday evenings.

A few of the shellers have cut back on their hours of operation this week down to three days a week. Yard tree sales have slowed as prices dropped last week due to quality issues and very little is coming in to be purchased. Interest from Asia, particularly China seems to have increased this week, especially when more pecans of export quality started to come onto the market this week and with the New Year holiday January 22 to February 5, 2023 rapidly approaching interest is peaking but getting the pecans shipped in time will be very challenging.

Large lots of Blends with Stuarts (nut count 55-60) 47-48% meat yield sold in a range of about \$3.25 per point. Large lots of Desirable Blends with 52-53% meat yields sold in a range of about \$3.36 per point. Small lots of Stuart Blends with 48-50% meat yields sold in a range of about \$2.90-2.95 per point. Small lots of Blends with Desirables and 50% meat yield sold in a range of about \$2.90-2.95 per point.

LOUISIANA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta, GA)

Temperatures are expected to be mild with days in the mid-60s and cooling for the weekend. It will climb back into the low 70s for Monday and Tuesday. There is a possible freeze for late Friday evening. Very light offerings for the year, with much of the commercial and retail-candy operations purchasing from other areas. Most growers are selling retail from their home businesses. Prices are holding steady.

Elliott (deliveries very light) machine harvested 130-140, yard tree lots 90-100

OKLAHOMA (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

Nice sunny days starting in the low 70s and cooling to the high 40s and low 50s for the weekend and back to mild days into the 60s for the rest of the week. Possible freeze for Thursday and Friday late evenings or early mornings. Most of the gift pack and retail candy industries are purchasing from out of state to fill orders. Some growers are still harvesting and collecting hoping to get some volume to be offered for sale later.

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Natives/Seedlings (deliveries very light) machine harvested 42% or better 125, yard tree lots 50-70

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TEXAS (Central, South, Eastern Areas) (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

Nice sunny days in the mid-80s and cooling to the 60s for the weekend, warming back up to the mid-70s for next week. Cooler evenings but no threat of freeze expected.

Growers are collecting their pecans before offering them for sale at this time, hoping to have some volume to sell in late January or February. A short crop and very light volume is expected. Some growers are putting them in cold storage until prices settle down. Some Natives should be available by the end of the week.

ARIZONA, NEW MEXICO AND WEST TEXAS (via: Forest Park-Atlanta GA)

Rain today with daytime temps in the low to mid-60s. Evenings in the mid-30s to low 40s. New Mexico will be cooler by about 5-10 degrees with evenings 28-34 degrees all week.

With a short crop and lower yields this year, many growers are selling retail online and through gift shops from home. Most are still collecting their pecans and trying to get enough volume to offer for sale later in the month or next month.

A few Blends of Western Schley with 60% meat yields sold in a range of about \$2.85-3.00 per point occasional \$3.05 per point.
